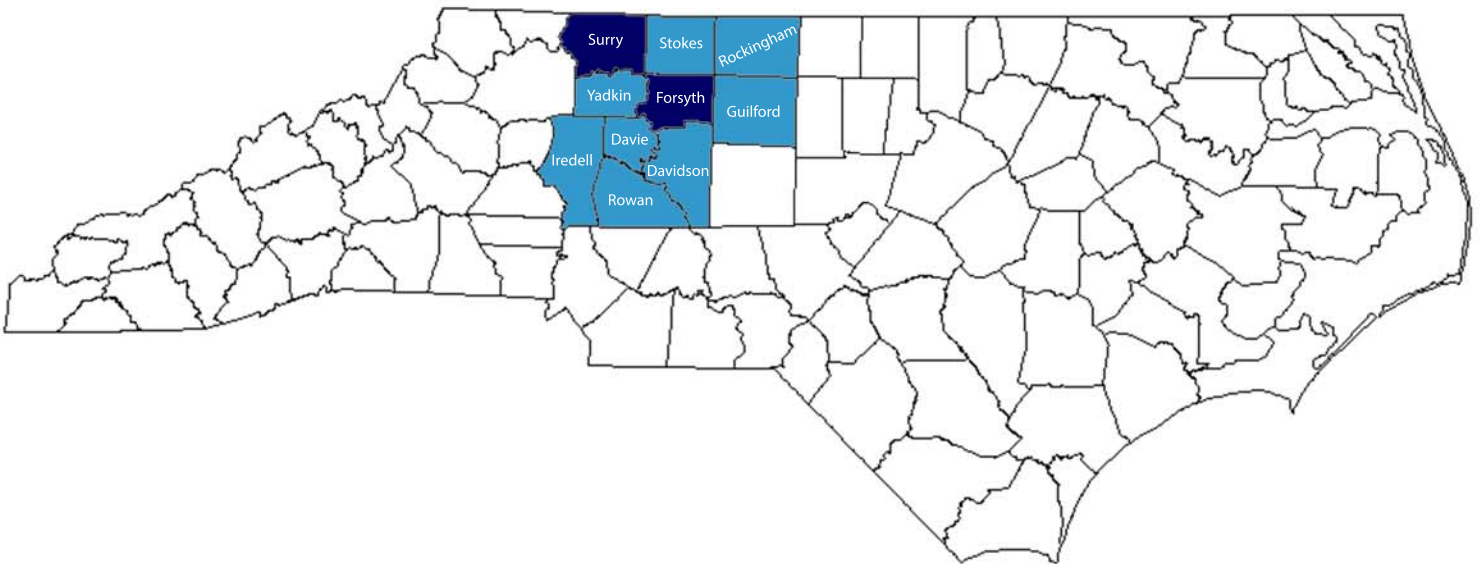


# About The Parenting PATH

## Services

### Parent Aide

Home-based intervention for at-risk families. Treatment can last up to 12 months with case management. Program available in Forsyth, Stokes and Surry counties.

### Fathers are Parents Too

A parenting class for fathers. Participants learn basic parenting skills, what it means to be a father, how to develop healthy relationships and improve physical and mental health. Meals and transportation offered.

### Parent/Teen Solutions

In home visitation services and 12 week group for parents and teens (12-17 years). Participants learn about healthy communication, relationships, and topics relevant to teens. Meals, transportation and childcare offered.

### Intensive Family Preservation Services (IFPS)

Intensive home visitation for families to prevent out of home placement of children. Services include: family assessment, intensive family and individual counseling, client advocacy, case-management, enhancement of parenting skills, and referral to other services as appropriate. Offered in Davidson, Davie, Forsyth, Iredell, Rockingham, Rowan, Stokes, Surry and Yadkin counties.

### Supervised Visitation

Safe supervision for parents to visit with their children. Parents may be in the midst of divorce, or impacted by 50B protection plans. Fee for services. Available for Forsyth county and surrounding region.

### Welcome Baby

Support for new parents provided in their homes. Referrals can be made and more information obtained by calling (336)725-Baby (2229).

- Welcome Baby provides 24-hour telephone counseling for parents with questions and/or concerns about infant care.
- Postpartum services and referrals available.
- Under 5 Club: Monthly educational group for moms and dads, with children under 5 years old.

### STA/SAFE (Systemic Treatment After Sexual Abuse)

Intervention for sexual abuse victims, siblings, parents/partners and offenders. Risk assessment for abuse reactive children, up to 18 years of age and adult offenders both male and female. Individual and group treatments available.

### Respite Care Program

Placement of children with collaborating agencies to reduce the potential for abuse and neglect. Parents or agencies can call 24 hours-7 days per week. Free. Transportation available. Available for Forsyth County residents.

### Positive Effective Parenting

12 week parenting class for parents at risk of abuse or neglect. Referrals by court order, professionals, or families.
