**8th Annual “Battle of the Bowls” Chicken Stew Cook-Off To benefit The Parenting PATH (Formerly Exchange/SCAN)
Saturday, October 13, 2018**

Categories for Awards:

- Judge’s Choice
- People’s Choice
- The Kettle Choice

Judge’s Choice will take place prior to the event opening to the public for tasting (approximately 3:30-3:45pm) General tasting will begin around 4:00pm.

People’s Choice will be determined at the end of the event by total number of tickets collected

The Kettle Choice will be determined based on donations received online and in person by 6:00pm on October 13. (donations can be made directly online at www.parentingpath.org and donor MUST indicate what team the donation is for in order to receive credit)

Cook Team Rules and Requirements:

1. Stews can be any tried and tested recipe that contains Chicken. It can be cream based, tomato based, plain, spicy etc. and must be identified for judging purposes. Cooks are expected to cover the cost of all ingredients needed for stew.
2. Stew should preferably be cooked off location. We want to keep it as sanitary as possible for all involved. A minimum of 10 gallons of stew is required. (If you would like to sell off stew for additional donations at the end of the event, please bring appropriate containers) *If we are able to provide containers teams will be notified prior to the event.*
3. Stew must be kept warm – gas or electric options are acceptable and are provided by cook teams.
4. Each team will have an electrical outlet and should provide their own extension cords.
5. The farmers market is a covered pavilion providing space for each team. One table will be provided per team, if you need additional tables please plan to bring one. You may decorate your area or bring a tent to decorate.
6. Cook teams may be as small as 2-person or as large as 4-person. We suggest wearing an apron or other distinguishable item so that attendees can identify cook team members.

7. All taste cups and soup bowls will be provided to the cook teams for serving. Tasting cups will be exchanged for 1 ticket = 1 vote. Attendees may purchase additional tastes for \$1 or bowls for \$3 to consume. Everyone must have a ticket to receive ANY stew from the entrants.
8. We ask all teams clean up their station in the pavilion. Volunteers will help clean up after the event, however teams are responsible for leaving their space as they found it.
9. Team meeting a week prior to the event will be held if needed.

These rules are preliminary and are subject to change.
