Judge's Choice will take place prior to the event opening to the public for tasting (approximately 3:30 to 3:45 PM). General tasting will begin at 4:00 PM.

People's Choice will be determined at the end of the event by total number of tickets collected by each team

Best Decorated will be based on originality, appearance and presentation

Cook Team Rules and Requirements:

- 1. Stews can be any tried and tested recipe that contains Chicken. It can be cream based, tomato based, plain, spicy etc. and must be identified for judging purposes. Cooks are expected to cover the cost of all ingredients needed for stew.
- 2. Stew should preferably be cooked off location. We want to keep it as sanitary as possible for all involved. A minimum of 10 gallons of stew is required. (If you would like to sell off stew for additional donations at the end of the event please do so. Appropriate quart containers with lids will be provided by us.)
- 3. Stew must be kept warm gas or electric options are acceptable and are provided by the cook teams.
- 4. Each team will have a dedicated 20 amp electrical outlet provided. You will provide any required extension cords.
- 5. The Farmer's Market is a covered pavilion providing a 10' by 16' space for each team. One 8' table will be provided per team. If you need additional tables please plan to bring one. You are encouraged to decorate your area or bring a tent to decorate.
- 6. Cook teams may be as small as 2-person. We suggest wearing an apron or other distinguishable item so that attendees can identify cook team members.

7. All taste cups and serving bowls will be provided to the cook teams.

Tasting cups (2oz) will be exchanged for 1 ticket = 1 vote. Attendees may purchase additional tastes for \$1 (1 ticket) or bowls (8oz) for \$4 (4 tickets) to consume. Quart take-home containers (32oz) will be \$10 (10 tickets).

Everyone must have a ticket to receive ANY stew from the entrants.

- 8. We ask all teams to clean up their station in the pavilion. Volunteers/Staff will help clean up after the event, however teams are responsible for leaving their space as they found it.
- 9. Team meeting a week prior to the event will be held if needed.
